

HOW TO USE A METRONOME

A metronome is a time-keeping device, digital or mechanical, that is used by musicians to set a Tempo (or speed), and for practice keeping a steady and even beat.

Some basic tempos that are marked on a metronome are:

Adagio
Moderato
Andante
Allegro

MECHANICAL or WIND UP: Slide the weight on the metal bar up tempo required.

DIGITAL: There are many different kinds of digital metronomes.]
press the arrows up or down until you get to the desired tempo.

METRONOME MARKINGS:

Much written music will indicate a tempo at the top of the page.
